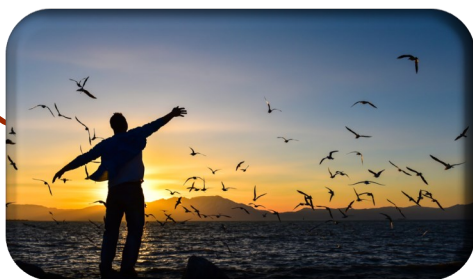
**"Called to Freedom" Ignatian weekend retreat, In-person only, Bethlehem Centre, Nanaimo, BC,**

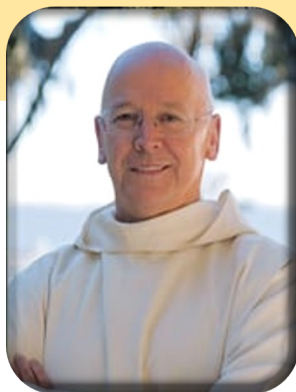


## ORDINATIONS OF PERMANENT DEACONS
