On behalf of our parish, we thank our donors to this year's Project Advance appeal. To date, we have raised just over \$40,000 towards our 2024 parish goal of \$125,000 from 64 donors (14 % of the total number of possible donors in our parish). We have now surpassed the Archdiocese allotment of \$34,700. Additional funds raised will now go to our own parish projects.

Our regular Sunday offerings pay for the day-to-day operating expenses of our parish. There is normally very little left over to help pay for improvements to our church and to fund our own special projects. One of the parish projects we have undertaken this year is to create an evangelical co-ordinator position to help spread the good news of our faith. Our parish community has been further strengthened through our Centennial projects which include the new statue of St. Anthony, refurbishing the Stations of the Cross and our celebratory gatherings. Project Advance also allows our church, through the Archdiocese, to reach out in a tangible way to our broader community by providing funds to help people in need in the downtown east side and through ministries in hospitals and prisons and many other initiatives.

As parishioners, we all benefit from the works made possible by Project Advance. We ask all parishioners to prayerfully consider donating to this year's appeal as their means will allow. All donations regardless of the amount, help to build our community and are gratefully received.

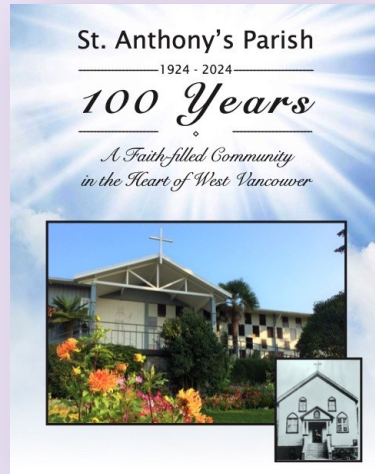
CENTENNIAL COMMEMORATIVE BOOK
