Please bring your picnic baskets and chairs.

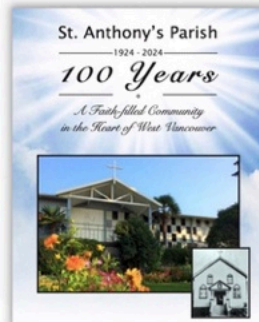
**Mission Parks Board regulation:** do not use charcoal briquettes, only propane can be used.
