KAIROS Blanket Exercise

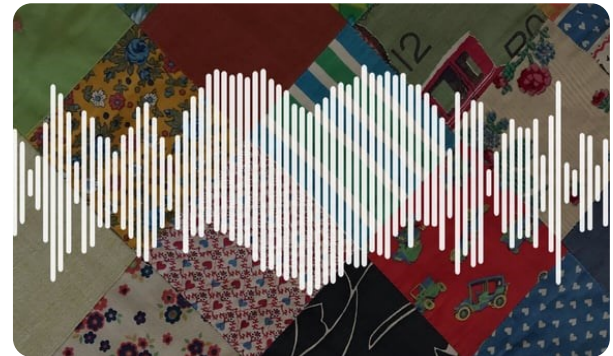
