

Dear brethren,

Last Friday we celebrated Saint Francis, the founder of the Franciscan order to which belongs our patron Saint Anthony. We are blessed to be spiritually related to such great saints. Saint Francis as we know had a high awareness of the need to befriend God's creation and to protect it. Today, following his example, we will bless our pets. A practice that we can understand better through this teaching of Saint Francis himself:


