MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

HEAVEN AND EARTH WILL PASS AWAY BUT MY WORDS WILL NOT PASS AWAY.

One Hebrew word is probably one of the most important in biblical studies. It is the word "DABAR" which means simply "word". Nevertheless, dabar means more than "word", in Hebrew it means also "thing", "matter", "speech", "command", "promise", "cause". This different meanings of the word DABAR could help us to understand how and why the word of God is not just about "words". In ancient Hebrew culture, words were considered powerful and significant. The spoken word was seen as an extension of one's character and authority. This is especially true for the word of God, which was believed to have creative and transformative power. The concept of "dabar" reflects the importance of communication and the belief that words can shape reality. Remember Psalm 33:6 "By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host."

His words are not just words....they are a command, they are a promise. "The word of the Lord is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" as says the psalm 119.

This reminds me of a Hymn I discovered some years ago:

Holy words long preserved
For our walk in this world
They resound with God's own heart
Oh, let the ancient words impart
Words of life, words of hope
Give us strength, help us cope

In this world, where e'er we roam Ancient words will guide us home Ancient words ever true Changing me and changing you We have come with open hearts Oh, let the ancient words impart.

Today I pray that you and I may rediscover the riches that is in the reading and meditation of the scriptures, the Word of God, the Dabar that is a promise and a command that will change our lives and bring us to fullness of life, enlightening us on our journey in this life.


