PLENARY INGULGENCES

INDULGENCES FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY DURING NOVEMBER – THE MONTH OF HOLY SOULS

Every year, from November 1 to November 8 (*the Octave of All Saints Day*), the Church grants an opportunity for a plenary indulgence that can be applied to the souls in purgatory. The faithful can obtain *one plenary indulgence* on *each* of these eight days for a soul in purgatory.

How to do this?

Visit a cemetery between November 1 and November 8 (or do so on each of these days).

Note: The cemetery you visit does not have to be the cemetery in which the person for whom you are praying is buried. Just go to the nearest cemetery (e.g., Capilano View Cemetery).

Think of the deceased person for whose soul you are praying, and recite these three prayers:

Our Father

The Apostles' Creed

The Eternal Rest Prayer:

Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them.

May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

General Requirements for Obtaining a Plenary Indulgence:

- Do the work while in a state of grace.
- Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days (several plenary indulgences may
 be earned per reception. In other words, if you desire to earn one plenary
 indulgence for souls in purgatory on each day from November 1 to 8, you need to
 go to confession only once, but you must fulfill the other requirements on each day
 you are attending the cemetery and praying.
- Receive Holy Communion (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception).
- Pray for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and one Hail Mary are enough).
- Have no attachment to sin (even venial). Make an act of will to love God and despise sin.

Even if you are not able to fulfill all these requirements but can only accomplish them in part, it is worth doing, as you can still receive a **partial indulgence** for the soul for whom you are praying!

The souls in Purgatory need our prayers!
