



Dear Parishioners,

We would like to introduce to you Bria Loeven. On March 9th, Bria participated in the Rite of Election at Holy Rosary Cathedral, thus taking her next step in her RCIA Journey to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. During these next few weeks, called the Period of Enlightenment, Bria will continue to prepare herself for Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion. If you attend the 10:30 am Mass this Sunday, March 30 and next Sunday, April 6, you will be able to pray together for Bria during the Scrutinies, which will include prayers aimed at strengthening and protecting Bria as she continues in the journey towards Baptism.

With Bria's permission, we would like to share with you a few words Bria shared with Father Arsene when asking to be enrolled in RCIA. "Since I was young, my mom taught me and exposed me to Christian values. She taught me how to pray, read to me C.S Lewis, and how to accept God's love and feel the Holy Spirit. Although she was the only Catholic in our immediate family, she taught me and let my spirituality grow without restrictions. 


40 DAYS FOR LIFE CAMPAIGN
