## PARISH EDUCATION COMMITTEE ELECTIONS

St. Anthony's School is a regional elementary school shared by St. Anthony's and Christ the Redeemer parishes. The Parish Education Committee consists of seven members, five elected by the parishes and two appointed by the Pastors. This year, both Christ the Redeemer and St. Anthony's have one Pastor appointed position open. Additionally, Christ the Redeemer Parish has two elected positions open, one for a two-year term and the second for a one-year term. If an election is necessary, the nominee with the highest number of votes will be elected to a two-year term, and the second nominee will hold a one-year term.

Natasha Boffo (St. Anthony's Parish) and Laura Rodriguez (Christ the Redeemer Parish), the Nominating Committee, are ready to receive nominations in the prescribed form from eligible candidates. Nomination forms are available at the Parish office.

All candidates nominated for election must be people of faith

committed to Catholic schools and the fostering of the Christian community in their parish. To serve on the PEC, one must be:

- a practicing Catholic, eligible to vote in this parish
- over the age of 21
- nominated by 2 people who also fit the above criteria
- approved by the Pastor

All completed Nomination and Statement of Commitment Forms must be submitted to the parish office by May 16, 2025. If more than two nominations are received, PEC elections will occur on the weekend of May 24 - 25, 2025, with voting following each Mass. The Elections and Procedures Subcommittee will closely supervise the election process.
