
# STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thank you so much for the warm welcome extended to me as the new Archbishop. I am really enjoying getting to know the people of this local Church.

One of the most important things I've learned from our Indigenous brothers and sisters across Canada is the power of listening.

Taking the time to hear someone's story is a way of saying: "You are worthy of being listened to." It is a way of honoring the dignity of the person.

As I begin my ministry here, I carry in my heart the call to truth and healing between the Church and Indigenous peoples. It has been part of my ministry for many years, and I have witnessed both the wounds of our past and the hope that grows when we walk together. One way we continue this journey is through our <a href="Healing and Reconciliation Collection on September 14">Healing and Reconciliation Collection on September 14</a>.

The projects supported by this collection are in partnership with First Nations communities. The initiatives are helping Indigenous peoples embrace their identity through language revitalization, cultural knowledge, and wellness. It connects individuals who may feel isolated and help ensure that those who have often faced discrimination can access healthcare and other services with dignity and respect.

These efforts remind us that reconciliation is not just an institutional effort, but a human journey that touches lives and builds hope, one person at a time. I invite you to pray for ongoing healing and consider supporting this collection. Together, we can help bring about the vision of unity to which Christ calls us.


