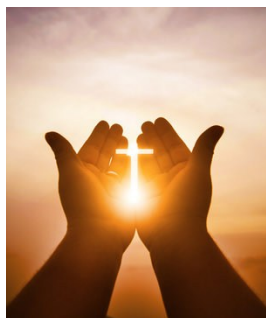

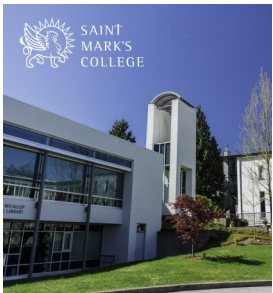
GO TELL IT ON THE MOUNTAIN—ADVENT RETREAT
