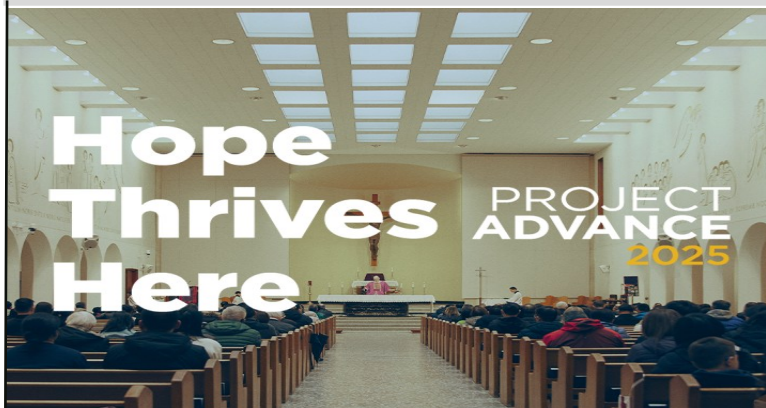

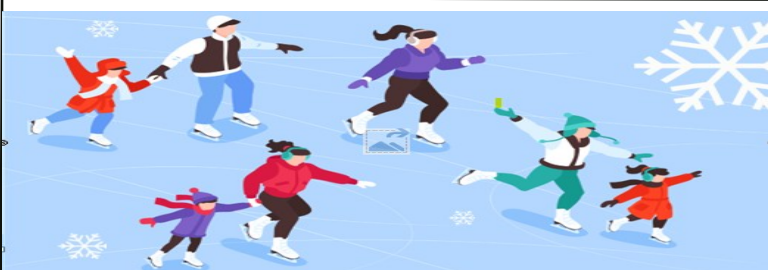
"Let us ask ourselves how and for whom do we spend our lives." - Fr. Arsène Dutunge.
