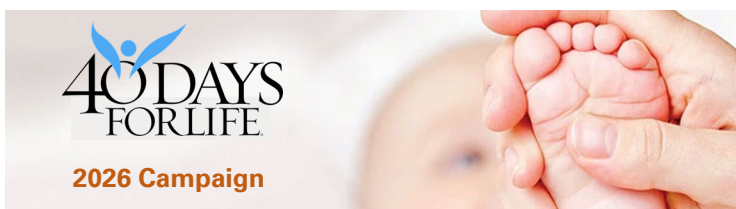

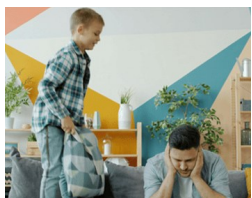
WORLD DAY OF THE SICK MASS WITH ARCHBISHOP SMITH
