Ash Wednesday marks the first day of Lent, the beginning of a 40 day season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, as we reflect on the Passion of Jesus and prepare ourselves to celebrate His Resurrection on Easter.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fasting for Catholics aged 18-59 and abstinence for those aged 14 and older. Abstinence is also practiced on all Fridays during Lent.

This weekend, please bring last year's palms which will be burned to make ashes to be distributed on Ash Wednesday. There is a basket in the foyer to collect them, thank you for your support.





2025 TAX RECEIPTS


Your 2025 Tax Receipts are now available for pick up in the church foyer. The 2026 offering envelope boxes will be in the parish office after this weekend.


