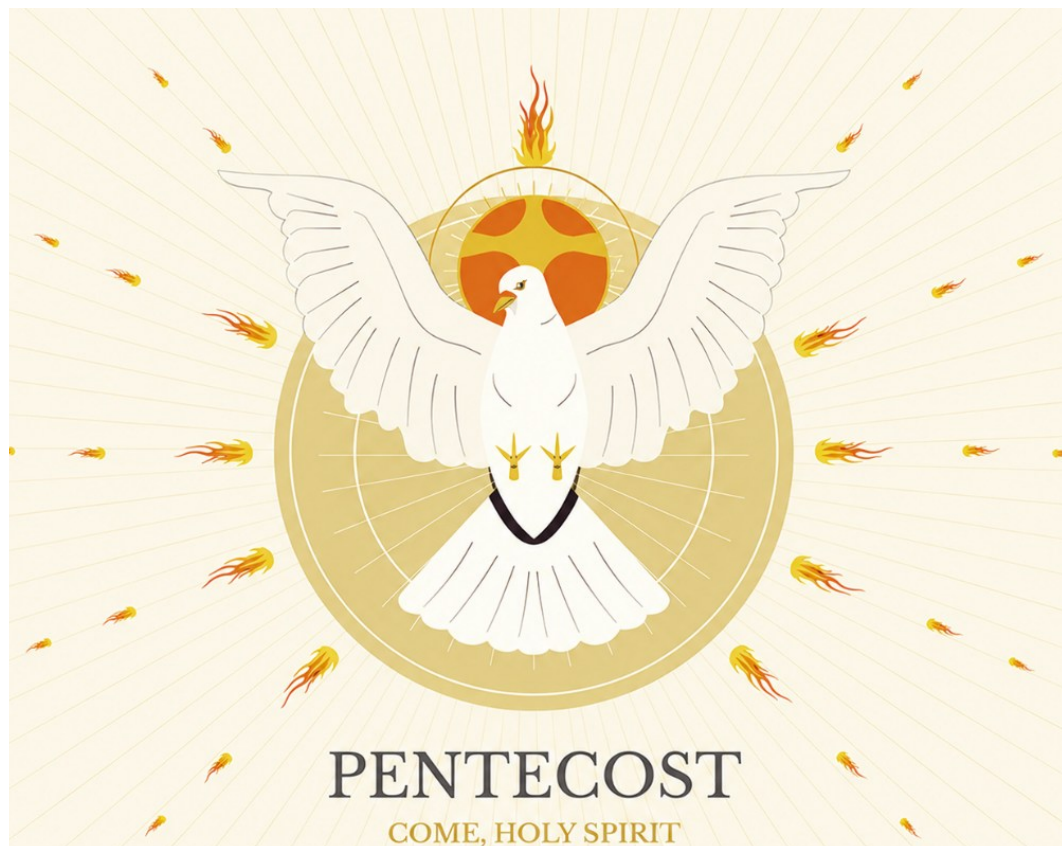

Please do not reply or purchase anything if you receive a message of this nature. You can always contact Father Arsène directly or the parish office at 604 - 926 - 6881 if you suspect a potential scam.

Protect yourself from fraud by recognizing key red flags:

- Scammers often create a false sense of urgency.
- They demand immediate payment using digital currency like e-transfers, gift cards or crypto.
- They send unsolicited emails asking you to click a link or verify a password.
