We ask you to kindly consider paying the full amount, as each copy represents a significant increase in cost to the church.

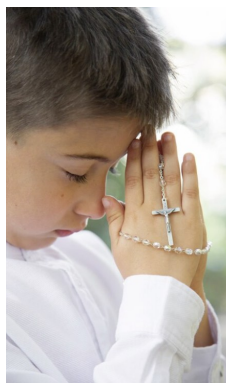

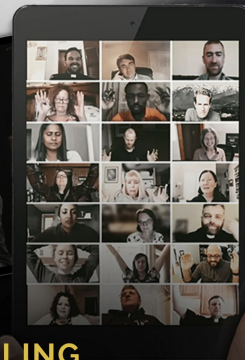

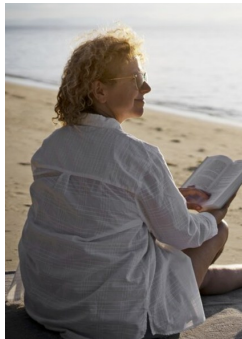
