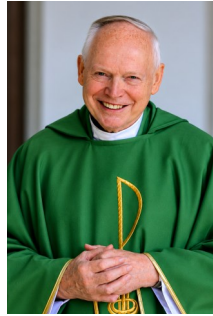

The Saint Anthony's Christian Meditation group will break for the summer and we will send out an email in August with our September start date. **There will be no group meeting on Tuesday June 23.**

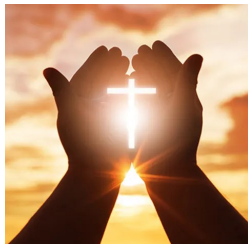
