The Missionary Oblates
of Mary Immaculate

On the weekend of September 19/20, we will welcome the *Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate* to be with us at all weekend masses: **Fr. Charles Okeyo OMI**, a young Kenyan Oblate and **Fr. Ken Forster OMI** who was one of the founding Oblate Missionaries serving in Kenya.

This year the **Oblates celebrate the 29th anniversary of their oblate kenyan mission**. Pope Leo XIV held a private audience in Rome with the Oblate Congregation in February, 2026, to celebrate the **200th anniversary of the Papal Approbation of the Constitutions and Rules of the Oblates**, originally approved by Pope Leo XII in 1826.

The Oblates arrived in Canada in 1841 to share the gospel and fulfill the mandate to **"Bring Good News to the Poor"**. After each Mass, Fr. Charles and Fr. Ken will be available to respond questions; a brochure will be handed to every family with the hope that you might take it home and discern if your family would like to partner with the Oblates in this great missionary work. We thank those parishioners who already reach out in support of this mission!
